

How do you model a building before it's built?

Post21, the London-based model-making studio and a Brick & Wonder member, faced exactly that challenge with Bergen Brooklyn, a 105-unit development in Boerum Hill designed by Taller Frida Escobedo.

The details had to do the talking.

Working alongside fellow collaborators at Avdoo & Partners and Pandiscio Green, the team translated a building defined by pleated concrete, private courtyards, and light-filled facades into something you could hold in your hands — before a single wall went up.

“Thin, stained, laser-cut plywood picks up the rhythm of the window frames, while glazing is largely set aside on the principal elevations, a deliberate abstraction that lets the model read as a sculptural object first.”
